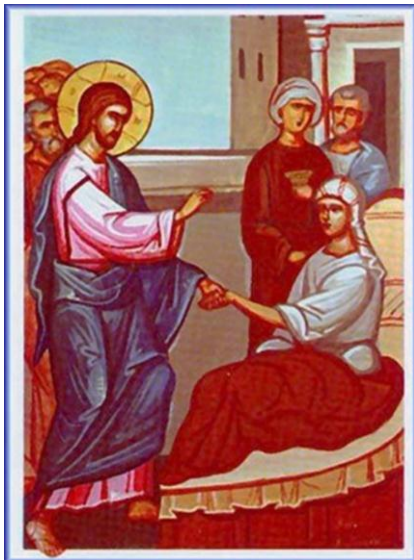
Must have received Sacrament of Confirmation.
